Each group will pick a security related topic and give a presentation on the topic as well as write a final research paper on their topic.

### **Part I (Due Wednesday, 10/7, via email to [dmarino@cs.ucf.edu](mailto:dmarino@cs.ucf.edu))**

Each group should give me document with their project topic choice and a detailed outline of what their final paper will look like. Please come and chat with me beforehand to make sure I think that the scope of your project is appropriate.

### **Part II (Monday, 10/21)**

Each group will turn in a written progress report in class showing what has been accomplished thus far.

### **Part III (Wednesday, 11/13)**

Each group will turn in rough draft of their final paper via email to [dmarino@cs.ucf.edu](mailto:dmarino@cs.ucf.edu). I will give general feedback for improvements I'd like to see in the final paper the following week.

### **Part IV (Monday, 11/18)**

Each group will turn in a detailed outline of their final presentation in class. I will give feedback if I am concerned about any of the outlines. If you don't hear from me, this means that I think your outline is reasonable.

### **Part V (Nov 22 - 27)**

Each group will make their presentation.

### **Part VI (Monday, 12/2)**

Each group will turn in their final paper via WebCourses.

### **How the project will be graded**

5% of the grade will come from the presentation and 10% of it will come from the paper. The checkpoints are merely there to help improve the quality of both items.
