

RP #2 - Grading Criteria

Note: The Grading Criteria for the Recitation Programs will differ significantly from the Individual Programs. Since you "know" if you got the problem correct, it's expected that only correct solutions will be submitted, for the most part. But since these programs have been specifically chosen to map to certain concepts in the class, significant points will be deducted if those concepts aren't properly used. The goal with these programs is to provide extra practice without a ton of time on the grader's end. Thus, the grading criteria will give very few points to any incorrect submission, and will deduct significant points if some key concept isn't properly displayed. For this assignment the key concept was floodfill.

Points for Correct Submission Picture and Corresponding Code: 25, if picture isn't submitted or if code is incorrect, give a maximum of 10 pts here.

Points for using Floodfill (must look at code): 10, 0 otherwise.

Points for Test Cases: 5 pts, 1 per test case, be pretty lenient here. Just see that their written explanation roughly matches the test case.

In General, Grader's Discretion to take off 1-5 points for any poor practice.
