

Fall 2016 COT 3100 Homework #1 Grading Criteria

Three questions to grade carefully:

Question #1

Question #3

Question #6

Each is worth 2 points. 0 if missing, 1 if about half correct or less, 2 pts otherwise.

Items to comment upon for each question:

Q1: Explain why some entries are incorrect, if there are any. Also, if you have trouble reading their writing, explain the importance of clear hand-writing.

Q3: They should have one expression per line, followed by the reason. If they don't, write enough so they get this message. If a reason is incorrect but the step is correct, write what the correct reason is and why. Similarly, if a step is incorrect, explain why they applied a rule incorrectly. Note that responses that arrive at the correct final result, p , may have incorrect steps in them, so it's not enough to see that they ended at p , you still have to read the steps.

Q6: Comment on any inaccuracies in notation if you see any. Clearly explain why some notation was inaccurate and write what the student had intended. If there was something wrong with the logic itself (hopefully this doesn't happen too much since the logic for TTT is pretty straightforward), then explain why what they expressed logically doesn't match up with how we tell if team X has won in TTT.

Questions 2,4 and 5 - very quickly eyeball and award 0, 1, 2, 3 or 4 points out of 4. As long as these look roughly complete please just give 4/4. Only give a lower score if there are very clear deficiencies that you can gauge by glancing at their responses for 15 seconds or fewer.
