

Grading Criteria COT 4210 Homework - Spring 2021

Grade awarded will be holistic. Here are the identifiers:

0 - No submission, or no single thing written makes any progress towards any solution.

1 - Submission with very little progress, less than 10% progress total.

2 - More than 10% but less than 50% of the work is correct.

3 - Slightly more than half of the work is correct.

4 - If a question or two is omitted with no attempt and the rest is solid (fits the description of a 5), then a four is awarded. Alternatively, if all questions are attempted but there is at least one conceptual error, then a 4 is awarded.

5 - Submission is reasonably complete. A solid attempt is made at each question and no large conceptual errors are present. All errors are minor details, such as typos, missing a single transition, issues that occur due to lack of concentration, not lack of understanding.

Glance at the homework for no more than 1 minute. Then, decide which grade to give it. Spend the rest of the time (probably 3-5 minutes per paper) giving qualitative feedback on the work. This could be pointing out the simple fixes to concentration errors, OR if there are conceptual errors, taking a bit more time to explain the underlying concept that isn't being understood and how that applies to a question.
