

COT 4210 Program #2 Grading Criteria

Execution Points (50 pts)

10 cases – 5 pts per case. You get full credit if all the strings for a particular case are correct. If some cases but less than half are off, you get 2 pts and if a majority of the cases are wrong, you get 0 pts.

If the code crashes, grade everything up until the point of the crash with a ceiling of 30 points. (Namely, even if 9 cases work correctly and the 10th crashes, only award 30 points.) Do NOT reorder cases in the file to see if subsequent cases to a crash worked.

If you find (in under 3 minutes) a simple error that greatly fixes the program, feel free to deduct a small number of points for that error and grade the program after that fix. You are not required to do this.

Other points (50 pts)

Turned in a .java file that looks relevant to the assignment – 20 pts (all or nothing)

The file turned in compiles – 10 pts (all or nothing)

All the input is read in appropriately – 5 pts (all or nothing)

Some attempt is made at “applying rules” – 15 pts (You can award partial credit here)
